PACKING INFO

Due to the Summer 2021 drop-off and pick-up procedures in place due to Covid-19 we ask all campers to pack their items in **ONLY** the following:

- sturdy trunk (preferred) or large duffle bag
- plastic drawers (must be taped closed on all sides)
- bag containing all bedding
- personal backpack

** Items not necessary for July Intro 2-week campers

CLOTHING

- 4-5 pairs of shorts
- 3-4 pairs of long pants
- 7-9 t-shirts
- 1-2 long sleeve shirts
- 10 underwear & socks
- 2-3 pajamas
- 3-4 warm tops (sweaters, fleeces, sweatshirts, etc.)
- 1-2 pairs of closed-toed shoes (sneakers, hiking boots, etc.)
- 1-2 pairs of opened-toed shoes (sandals, crocs, etc.)
- 2-3 bathing suits
- 1 nicer outfit for Mid-Birthday**
- raingear (boots/jacket)
- hat for sun (baseball, bucket, etc.)

OPTIONAL

The following is a list of fun items to have at camp but are not required:

- camera (digital or disposable)
- letter/postcard writing materials
- stamps
- books
- swim goggles
- mosquito netting
- stuffed animal
- musical instruments/sports equipment
- "crazy creek type" chair

UNIFORM**

Uniforms are worn only for special events and traditions. Items marked with * are required. Information regarding where to purchase uniforms is shared later in this guide.

- 1 pair dark green FDL shorts*
- 1-2 white collared FDL camp shirts*
- white sneakers*
- white socks*
- FDL sweatpants
- FDL sweatshirt

EQUIPMENT

- mesh laundry bag
- bedding
 - 3-4 blankets
 - 2 sets of twin sheets
 - 1 pillow with 2 pillowcases
 - sleeping bag (to be used for extra blanket & campouts)
- 2-3 shower towels
- 2-3 beach towels
- toiletries in a small bucket
 - toothbrush
 - toothpaste
 - shampoo & conditioner
 - body wash
 - hairbrush
 - feminine hygiene products
- sunscreen
- bug repellent
- 2 flashlights or headlamps with extra batteries
- 2 reusable, dishwasher safe water bottles
- 10 machine washable face coverings
