

Visitors at Fleur de Lis Camp

We are excited to now be able to open camp in a limited way to visitors! Walking and picnicking on our grounds are acceptable activities at this time, provided the following guidelines are followed:

1. Visitors must request a time and date to visit in advance by emailing MJ Parry at mj@fleurdeliscamp.org which will avoid having multiple groups on our site at a time.

Note: According to the State of NH Covid-19 Guidelines, at this time only visitors from the 6 New England states (Maine, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut and New Hampshire) are allowed to visit. Anyone from other states must adhere to a mandatory 14-day quarantine.

2. Park in the gravel parking lot at the far end of the Dining Hall & Director's House – please do not park on the grass.
3. Visitors must sign in and out on the clipboard located on the Dining Hall porch
4. **Visitors must wear facemasks at all times** and adhere to NH & CDC social distancing guidelines:

5. Visiting groups may not exceed 10 people.
6. No one may be on our docks at any time. There is no swimming nor any other water activities allowed from any waterfront area in our site.
7. Carry In – Carry Out: All trash and recyclables must be taken with you upon departure.
8. Pets must be on leash unless specific permission is given by Executive Director. Please pick up after your pet.
9. All buildings and facilities are locked – please note that includes bathrooms. Bring your own water.
10. Visitors must be respectful of the safety of our staff and/or volunteers working on site by practicing social distancing and wearing face masks.
11. **If you are exhibiting any symptoms of Covid19, have been exposed to anyone with Covid19, or have been in situations that may have exposed you to the virus, please do not visit camp.**
